# **CONTRACT RIDER**

# **TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS**

#### A. STAGE

- 1. Staging in auditorium/theater/ballroom 32' x 16' is ideal. The bigger, the better. If your stage is smaller, talk to the artist about flexibility.
- 2. If the stage is portable, please be sure to have safety rails on the sides and back.
- 3. Equipment/Supplies
  - 15-20 folding, armless, stackable chairs
  - 2 roll gray duct/gaffe tape
  - 3 bottles of water

#### **B. SOUND**

The ARTIST always travels with his own sound system (UNLESS FLYING IN). But in the event it is not enough, use the following below:

- 1. A sound system powerful enough to handle the room, 2 stage monitors facing the ARTIST and volunteers. If you have questions, we will be as flexible as possible.
- 2. 2 wireless handheld microphones with 2 mic stands
- 3. 1 XLR port on or near the stage for the ARTIST'S Bluetooth adapter for music
- 4. 1 1/4inch port on or near the stage for the ARTIST'S additional cords

#### C. LIGHTING

1. General stage lighting with white light that can be dimmed as well as the house lights is ideal, but most lighting configurations are workable.

#### D. CAMERA TECHNICIAN

1. Someone who can meet the ARTIST before the show to help run a camera during the show

### E. HOSPITALITY

- 1. Dressing room convenient to the performance area with bathroom facilities
- 2. Several bottles of water
